

Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Commission (FCHRC) Scholarship in Honor of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

<u>Objective:</u> This scholarship is available to any Cumberland County high school, private school, and home school graduating senior for financial assistance towards his/her attendance to a two or four-year college or university of their choice.

<u>Administration of the Program:</u> The Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Commission will use the following criteria to determine a student's eligibility for receiving this scholarship. All applications and records of awards will be kept by the Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Department.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Student has resided in Cumberland County at least one year immediately prior to applying for this scholarship;
- 2. Student will be a senior in a high school located in Cumberland County;
- 3. Student has maintained an average of 2.50 GPA (unweighted) or better; and
- 4. Student has been admitted as a full-time student in an accredited course of study to a two or four-year college or university.

Amount of Scholarship: \$1,000

<u>Application:</u> Applications may be obtained from your high school's Guidance Department or from the Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Department, Festival Park Plaza, 225 Ray Avenue, Suite 108, Fayetteville, NC 28301, (433-1696) or at the Cumberland Community Foundation website: http://www.cumberlandcf.org/scholarships-2/how-to-apply-2/ and stroll to the bottom of the page and click on Application for FCHRC/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Scholarship.

Requirements:

- 1. The application must be filled in completely, including the information requested in numbers 12 through 14, which should be submitted on additional pages by **March 5, 2018**;
- 2. An official high school transcript must accompany the application; and
- Three letters of recommendation must accompany the application packet, letters must be <u>signed</u> or applications will be considered incomplete.

Scholarship Evaluation

1.	Financial Need	50 points	Be very clear in explaining your financial need and how this scholarship will assist you.
2.	Academics	25 points	Be sure to include your official high school transcript. (See your Guidance Counselor)
3.	Essay	15 points	500-600 words
4.	Leadership	10 points	Include all of your extra-curricular activities, community activities and/or projects where you have been an active participant. Please note any offices you have held.

5. Completed application packet

Only completed application packets will be reviewed by the Scholarship Review Committee. *Applications without parent/guardian signature will not be considered.
